May they rest in peace and God Bless them all.



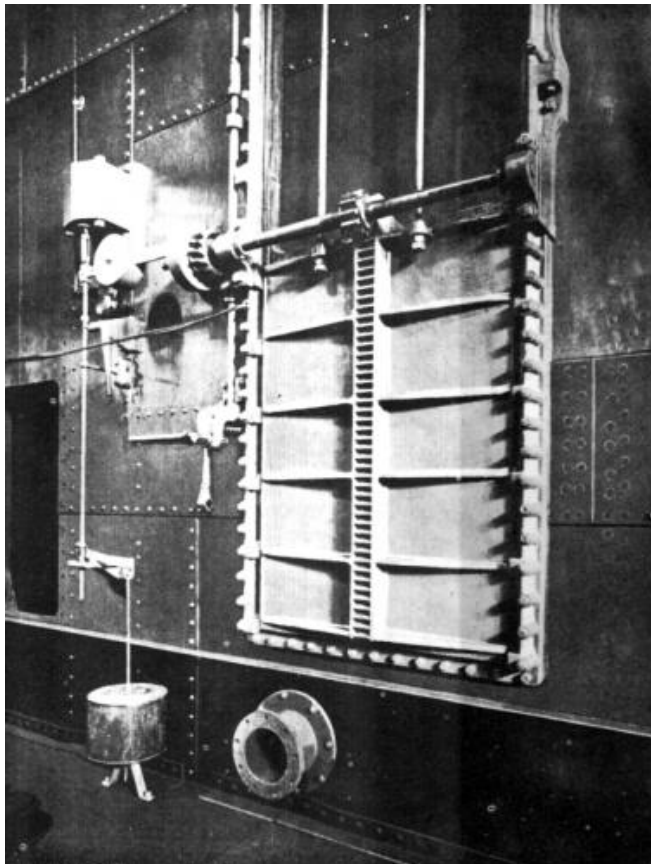
This is an autobiography of a dog who risked his own life to save a lifeboat of people from being rammed by the ocean liner Carpathia during the rescue attempt.
