I have always been interested in learning by Colouring, but not in reading. I have designed this eBook in a way that helps preschool children, from the start, to get interested in words by listening, following the printed words, playing and having fun.

This colouring book aims to teach two-year-olds and up, by listening to the stories relating to the alphabet, by recognising words, repeating what is read to them - using a full range of essential skills to prepare them for life and making reading and learning fun!

Your child will quickly learn to recognise, identify and associate pictures with words to start reading and writing.

Read the story aloud while pointing to each word, so your child can see the names, letting them repeat the words. Let them tell you when they see or hear the word. Another way is to sing the words, making it a song and dance book. Like the way we sing "Happy Birthday to you".

This eBook is for parents to read the stories with their child to show how in each story it uses the alphabet related to each letter.

I do hope you and your child enjoy using this reading and colouring book and spending quality time together.

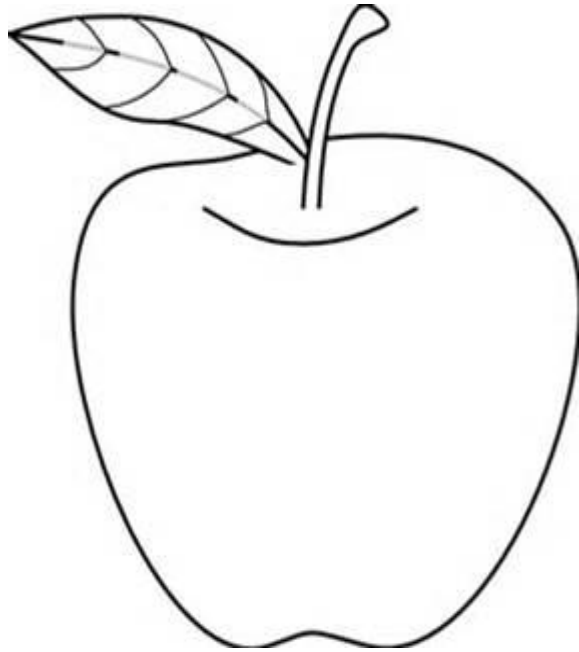


The first letter of the alphabet is A,
and the last is Z

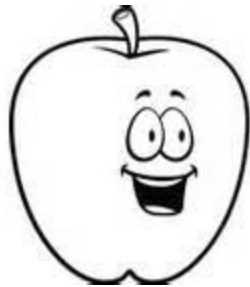
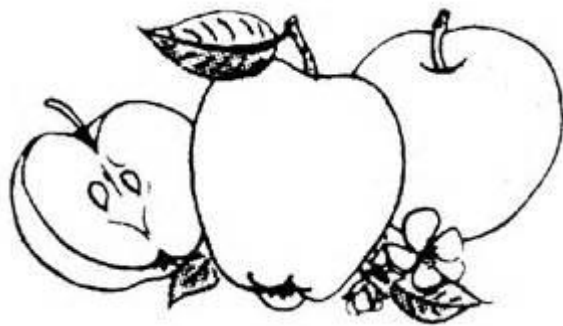
