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## How To Do Word Search And Solve These Mysteries

Find the words in the grid. The words can be found diagonally, horizontally or vertically. They can be spelled either backwards or forwards.

Each word search puzzle contains a hidden message.
That message consists of clues to solve the mystery. The clues will pertain to the name of the puzzle. For instance, a puzzle titled "victim", would have a hidden message with clues telling you who the crime was committed against.

To find the hidden message, first solve the puzzle. Then start at the top left and go across row by row and write down each unused letter you find in the blank spaces at the bottom of the page. The letters will spell out the clues. Then deduce what the clues are trying to tell you.

There is a special page for each mystery so you can write down your deductions from the clues. And another page for you to construct your version of the mystery in your own words.

All answers are in the Answer Key at the back of the book.
Have fun sleuthing!
