Those seeking repatriation might be willing to support a development initiative, may be willing to bankroll an effort. Let's start the conversation there."

Safe Haven Criteria

An excellent starting point is to select a country that has taken aggressive steps in the following areas:

1. Eradicates corruption.
2. Protects freedom of speech and the press.
3. Offers a safe, secure and stable social and political environment.
4. Provides for and encourages full citizen participation in government affairs (voting and seeking public office).
5. Minimal incidence of terrorist acts and violent demonstrations.
6. Good relations with the neighboring nations.

Based on the latest from several independent sources including the Global Peace Index we have identified twenty (20) African countries most mentioned, from various sources, as the safest to visit and live.

CAVEAT..If you are inclined to select a country based on your DNA ancestral results, I would caution that as noble as repatriating to one's ancestral home might be, the safety of you and your family must take precedence over ancestral ties.
