INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this book is to establish what the scriptures teach about the Tithe. The people that I speak of as the chosen people were indeed Hebrew/Ivriym. I will list those restored names and I will also list the changed names next to the restored name as much as possible.

An example of what I am speaking of is the restored name of the creator, whose true name is Yahuah. In the KJV for example you will see a title description being used instead of a name that says LORD/the Lord, within the scriptures and is not a translation of the name of Yahuah. It has been stated that the name of Yahuah was changed to the LORD over 6,900+ times within the KJV. There's no legitimate reason as to the changing of the name of Yahuah by the KJV translators, but it was done according to prophecy in Jeremiah/Yirmeyahu 23:27. You will see the words Ruach HaQodesh being used which many call in the KJV the Holy Spirit. I will also be using scripture from the Apocrypha books as well. These books were in the KJV 1611 Version and were later removed. The interesting thing about the name Apocrypha is the meaning of the book is, to be kept secret or to be hidden. Someone didn't want everyone to read those books for a reason. I will suggest that you have your scriptures with you when going through this book so that there is no situation where someone thinks that I am misquoting scripture. I have presented a lot of facts within this book that deals with this subject matter of the Tithe and I hope that it's a great read as well as a learning experience for everyone.
