

### PROOFING YOUR HOME

Secure Hazardous Items	Store cleaning supplies, chemicals, and medications in locked cabinets.  Keep small objects that could be swallowed out of reach.  Secure electrical cords to prevent chewing.
Safe Zones	<ul> <li>Designate a puppy-proofed area with a crate, bed, and toys,</li> <li>Use baby gates to limit access to certain rooms or areas,</li> </ul>
Chew-Proofing	<ul> <li>Provide plenty of safe chew toys to deter destructive chewing.</li> <li>Remove or secure items like shoes, cables, and cords.</li> </ul>
Household Plants	<ul> <li>Remove toxic plants that could be harmful if ingested.</li> <li>Research pet-safe plants to add greenery to your space.</li> </ul>
Trash and Recycling	Use lidded trash cans to prevent scavenging.  Keep recycling and compost containers out of reach.
Cords and Wires	Tuck away or cover cords to discourage chewing. Use cord protectors or bitter-tasting sprays.
Furniture and Decor	<ul> <li>Anchor heavy furniture to the wall to prevent tipping.</li> <li>Remove fragile or valuable items from low surfaces.</li> </ul>
Kitchen Safety	<ul> <li>Avoid leaving food on counters or tables.</li> <li>Keep sharp objects and hot surfaces out of reach.</li> </ul>
Laundry Room Precautions	Store detergents and laundry pods securely.     Keep laundry baskets closed to prevent chewing.
Windows and Screens	<ul> <li>Make sure windows are securely screened to prevent escapes.</li> <li>Avoid leaving windows open where a puppy could slip through.</li> </ul>
Stairs and Balconies	<ul> <li>Block off stairs or balconies until your puppy can navigate them safely,</li> </ul>
Childproof Locks	Use childproof locks on cabinets containing potentially harmful items,
Hidden Wires	Conceal or secure exposed wires from lamps and electronics.
Tabletops and Counters	Train your puppy to stay off tables and counters to avoid accidents.
Secure Trash Bins	Opt for bins with tight-fitting lids to discourage exploration.
